The Enneagram: A powerful tool for self-understanding. The system, a concise personality theory, offers profound insights in the nine ways people are motivated. These motivations, though they initially lead us to a specific set of skills, ultimately poison our relationships and constrict our ability to dream. The Enneagram is an elegant tool for identifying these constrictions and transforms our ability to be who we want to be.

The Map of Emotions: A method to move rapidly from chronic moods such as resentment, self-pity, and resignation through intense emotions like anger, grief, and despair to unfolding positive states like joy, love, and compassion. The Map was developed as a clinical approach to assist both clients and therapists in resolving and dissolving intense emotions without getting bogged down in content. While just standing still with a certain amount of willingness and practice, working the Map of Emotions generates a healing “resonance” that is empowering, nurturing and energizing.
