<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • An Enneagram professional with advanced knowledge of the Enneagram and a depth of professional Enneagram-related practical experience. • Must be a current IEA Professional Member; • Must have accrued at least 250 points in accordance with the IEA AP Scoring System as a result of: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) In-person Enneagram trainings completed over at least 3 years time, other qualifying Enneagram training and study, and other qualifying educational achievements in related fields (minimum of 150 points); and b) Qualifying Enneagram-related professional work performed over the course of at least 3 years (minimum of 100 points). • Must submit two qualifying letters of recommendation from Enneagram professionals (IEA Accredited Professionals where possible). • Adheres to the ethical standards of the IEA. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • An in-depth training program that is designed and delivered from advanced knowledge of the Enneagram and provides either comprehensive Enneagram education or a specialized focused on a specific Enneagram approach or application. Trainings programs are eligible for accreditation; workshops are not. • Offered and taught by one or more sponsoring IEA Accredited Professionals or a sponsoring IEA Accredited Enneagram School. • May be a single event lasting 4-5 days focused on a specific approach to or application of the Enneagram (typically 35-40 hours) or a series of multiple sequenced events constituting a comprehensive Enneagram education program (typically 40-100 hours or more). • Must be regularly offered using a consistent curriculum and must have been taught in full at least twice prior to application. A link to a current online description of the program and information about when and where it is offered must be provided. • Grants a Certificate of Completion and/or a Certification for a specific Enneagram approach or application. • May or may not assess mastery for Certification. • Adheres to the ethical standards of the IEA. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • An organization that has existed for at least two years prior to application and that regularly offers basic and advanced Enneagram trainings, including one or more IEA Accredited Training Programs, providing a comprehensive Enneagram education or in-depth Enneagram education in a particular field. • Grants a professional certification (teacher, coach, facilitator, etc.) upon completion of either a comprehensive study of the Enneagram (typically consisting of 100 or more hours of study) or an in-depth study of a particular approach or in a particular field. • Certification typically requires fieldwork and/or a formal assessment in addition to completion of the training program requirements. • The sponsoring individual(s) and all core Enneagram faculty must be IEA Accredited Professionals. • A link to a current online description of ongoing course offerings and the Certification program requirements must be provided for inclusion on the IEA website. • Typically provides advanced programs and/or ongoing learning and deepening practice opportunities for its graduates. • May offer additional workshops, courses and retreats that are not part of its Accredited Training Program and Certification program. • Adheres to the ethical standards of the IEA.
<p>Accredited Professional With Distinction: Recognition that may be applied for by IEA Accredited Professionals who have been teaching or using the Enneagram professionally for 15 or more years, have been accredited for at least 5 years and/or made other significant contributions to the IEA or Enneagram field, have presented at IEA global or regional conferences at least twice, have adhered to the ethical standards of the IEA, and have been recommended by at least 2 other IEA Accredited Professionals for this recognition.</p>
