

IEA Accredited Professional Scoring System

I. Enneagram Training and Education Points (*minimum of 150 total points required*)

A minimum of 150 total training and education points are required with at least 100 of such points coming from qualified Enneagram trainings taking place over a minimum of 3 years prior to application. See the [IEA Accredited Professional Requirements](#) on the website for a complete description.

A. Qualified Enneagram Trainings, Courses and Workshops (*minimum of 100 points over at least 3 years*)

* All trainings, workshops and courses must be stand-alone events requiring advance registration and payment (or admission by scholarship). Applicants, by submitting application, certify that the full course was participated in and completed.

**Copy of Certificate must be provided to obtain bonus points.

II. Enneagram-Related Professional Work (*minimum of 100 points over at least 3 years*)

A minimum of 100 points of Enneagram-related professional work performed directly by the Applicant as a primary content provider using the Enneagram as a primary tool over at least 3-years prior to application are required. A. Practical Enneagram-Related Professional Work

Type of Work	Points/Percentage related to Enneagram
T = Teaching or presenting to pre-arranged groups or private clients F = Leading or facilitating retreats, panels, other group experiences C = Coaching individuals BC = Business consulting or coaching and training in organizations TH = Psychotherapy/Psychological Consulting SD = Spiritual Direction or Pastoral Counseling BB = Somatic or Body-based professional work (including movement, dance, voice, etc.) P = Hosting or presenting on a podcast or other social media or media platform with at least 100 subscribers/viewers O = Other (Committee will determine points, if any)	1 point per hour (up to a maximum of 8 hours per day) for work performed by Applicant in a primary role using the Enneagram as a primary tool. If the Enneagram is one of several tools used in performing the work, a good-faith percentage estimate of the portion of the work using the Enneagram as a primary tool must be given and the points awarded will be reduced accordingly.

In addition to hours teaching and worked (above), points may be earned as follows:
