

IEA LIVE Policy

Purpose:

IEA LIVE's primary purpose is to provide high-quality transmission of the Enneagram to the IEA Global community by allowing Professional IEA members and IEA Affiliate approved members to present on an Enneagram-related topic. Also, allowing the questions from attendees to be taken and answered by the presenters.

IEA Live's secondary purpose is to provide additional benefits to IEA Global members. Professional members have the opportunity to apply to present, and all IEA Global members can attend IEA LIVE events for free.

IEA LIVE's tertiary purpose is to provide a low-cost avenue for non-IEA Global members to access high-quality Enneagram teachings and to provide an introduction and pathway to IEA membership and benefits.

Our goal is to generate sufficient revenues to at least cover costs and possibly make a profit.

Who is included and who can participate:

IEA LIVE is open to IEA Global members and non-members. IEA Global members have free access to IEA LIVE events. Non-members including IEA Affiliate members who are not either a member of the hosting affiliate or an IEA Global member must pay a fee to attend which is currently \$20.

Criteria for IEA LIVE presenter selection:

Presenters for IEA LIVE are selected in the following ways.

1. IEA Events Committee approves a presenter to speak from current IEA professional level members who submit an application suggesting a topic and program outline
2. IEA Events Committee approves a presenter to speak from current IEA professional level members previously selected to present the offered topic at an IEA global conference
3. IEA Events Committee approves an IEA Affiliate or Chapter to sponsor a presentation and such Affiliate/Chapter chooses one or more of its current members to present on a proposed topic.

The IEA Events committee (or global Events Committee) reserves the right to decline any topic or chosen member from an IEA Affiliate or Chapter who is deemed detrimental to the IEA Global purpose or community, or who violates the IEA's ethical guidelines or code of ethics.

The IEA Events committee will develop, recommend and modify from time to time as needed processes and procedures for soliciting and evaluating applications from IEA professional members and IEA Affiliates and Chapters to present at or host IEA LIVE sessions with a goal to creating a fair and open process and attracting and scheduling an annual balanced program featuring a wide variety of presenters and engaging topics, consistent with the IEA's vision and goals.

All selected IEA LIVE presenters must provide program title, descriptions and materials, including names and photos, suitable for use in promoting the program by the deadlines determined by the Events committee in consultation with IEA staff.

The Goals:

IEA LIVE's primary goal is to transmit high-quality Enneagram teachings from high-quality teachers around the world representing a diversity of Enneagram lineages and applications.

IEA LIVE's second goal is to increase our IEA Global membership by creating regular, engaging, high-quality Enneagram events.

The Significance:

IEA LIVE is a unique way to present high-quality Enneagram teachings and teachers to the IEA Global community as a benefit of being a member. It also allows for a global connection through a virtual platform. IEA LIVE also gives attendees access to engage with the high-quality presenters through thoughtful questions. This monthly event keeps the IEA community connected, engaged, and informed of upcoming IEA events.

The General Structure:

IEA LIVE presentations currently take place on the 3rd Friday of each month at 3:00pm Eastern time. The event lasts 90 minutes. A member of the IEA Global board or the IEA Affiliate member will facilitate each session and ensure that the IEA's values and ethical guidelines are adhered to.

Translation will be determined on a session by session basis depending on cost. Presentations in languages other than English must be translated to English as the most common shared language amongst the global IEA community and the base language from which translation to other languages most often is possible. If a session is proposed to be sponsored by an IEA Affiliate in a language other than English, an effort should be made to locate a volunteer or low cost translator from the Affiliate's community or membership.

IEA LIVE sessions are conducted on Zoom and are recorded for inclusion in the IEA member Library.

This policy and any future revisions to it are to be approved by the IEA Global Events Committee and/or the IEA Board.
